The Sasquatch Brew Fest was preceded the prior evening by a fabulous brewers dinner with food by Wild Duck Catering and beer from Steelhead, Rock Bottom, McMenamins High Street, Laurelwood, and Rouge Ales/Eugene City Brewery.

The all-day event also featured six bands, with varied acts from Strange Brew to Bill Willie Blues to Sirius Jones. Throughout the day, Brew Fest goers enjoyed plenty of great food and a lot of friendship and sunshine. The day of celebration was complete with a lively raffle and exciting silent auction.
